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## Learn to listen - listen to Learn

Piano students of Miriam Eley are required to attend two (2) concerts during the academic year and submit a program along with a written impression of their listening experiences. An outline and listening guide will be supplied to each student for each concert they wish to attend.

Programs from the concerts and written comments from the students should be returned to the Conservatory (Room 109) and they will be placed in a scrapbook. The scrapbook will be located in the studio and parents/students are formed. Please try to attend different welcome to look through the scrapbook during types of concerts so you can develop better your son or daughter's lesson.



All concerts need to be attended by the end of May, 2009. Students and parents are encouraged to attend as many concerts as possible but remember - only 2 are required for the year as we learn to listen and listen to learn!
